Key Scripture

Romans 12:2 Be not conformed to this world but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind that ye may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Romans 8:6 (KJV) For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

- *Carnally minded* - flesh, unrenewed, soulish realm mind
- *Spiritually minded* - renewed mind

Romans 8:7-8 (NIV) The mind (*Carnal*) governed by the flesh it does not submit to God's law, nor can it do so. Those who are in the realm of the flesh (*Carnal*) cannot please God.

If you do not take the time to renew your mind, you will not believe or be able to receive the promises from God, and will not be able to walk in them.

- Your soul is your decision maker on what you're going to believe and receive.

How many believe that it takes Christ in you, to get you out of here when the rapture takes place? How many of you have what it takes right now to get you out of here, should HE come today?

Notes:

You have what it takes inside of you to do these things Jesus did, because it's Christ in you that enables us to:

- Heal the sick.
- Cast out devils.
- Raise the dead.

Matthew 10:8 (KJV) Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.

Notes:

Galatians 2:20 (NKJV) I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

2 Corinthians 5:21 (NLT) For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ.

2 Corinthians 3:18 (NLT) So all of us who have had that veil removed can see and reflect the glory of the Lord. and the Lord--who is the Spirit--makes us more and more like him as we are changed into his glorious image.

This is why we need a renewed mind. The devil still wants to convince you, that you are still just an old sinner with a bad past. We need to tell him this:

2 Corinthians 5:17 (NKJV) Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

We are new in Christ and have His same ability to do the works that He did!

Notes:

John 14:12 (KJV) Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father.

If we have the Spirit of God to get us to heaven, we have the Spirit of God

to do the works He called us to do. We want all of you walking and operating in the Word.

Ephesians 6:13 (KJV) Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

Ephesians 6:17 (KJV) And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

How do we do this with the armour and our weapons:

- By renewing our mind
- Speaking it out of our mouths

Your greatest weapon against the enemy is the word coming out of your mouth with a renewed mind. You **will know** you are going to **receive** what you are speaking.

Proverbs 18:21 (NLT) The tongue can bring death or life, those who love to talk will reap the consequences.

Proverbs 18:21 (ISV) The power of the tongue is life or death--those who love to talk will eat what it produces.

James 3:5 (GNB) So it is with the tongue: small as it is, it can boast about great things. Just think how large a forest can be set on fire by a tiny flame!

Notes:

It's up to you which words your tongue will speak. Life or Death. But whatever you choose you will have whatever you keep saying whether it's good or bad.

- Prophecy to yourself, the word of God
 - **Psalms 91:16** *With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation.*

We have this same ability because God lives in our spirit by the Holy Spirit.

- **Romans 4:17 (NKJV)** *(as it is written, “I have made you a father of many nations”) in the presence of Him whom he believed-- God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did.*

Romans 8:11 (NIV) AND if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of ***his Spirit who lives in you.***

Look at yourself from the inside out. Your reborn Spirit now has Christ living in it. You are never alone and always have the one to give you instructions in you.

Job 22:28 (YLT) And thou decreest a saying, And it is established to thee, And on thy ways hath light shone.

Job 22:28 (WEB) You shall also decree a thing, and it shall be established to you. Light shall shine on your ways.
